- 2nd NdoH planned workshop for Anaesthetic booklet Bongani Regional Hospital
- Onsite trainings and Mentorship in facilities
- Portogram Video recording that was played on ICAM reaching 30 sites.
- Monthly ICAM schedule covered the intrapartum care guidelines.
- Continued ESMOE training as part of the modules

Challenges

- **There was a time when other facilities were using the old book.**
- **During time of not enough/no stock of booklet , facilities are printing the document.**
- **Some facilities resistant to use new guidelines as these was not included in the 2016 guidelines.**
- **Shortage of staff affect correct use as audit shows inconsistence use evident when comparing patient profile**

- **All facilities using new Intrapartum care guidelines**
- **Printing of MCR done and old books taken out of circulation**
- **Monthly audits on partogram by facilities and DCSTs**
- **Partogram Audits > 80% added as element in CARMMA audit tool.**
- **Sharing of Maternity Case Recorded with private Midwives & Drs included in the CARMMA strategy to enforce usage across health care sector.**
