

Grow Great believes in a future where no child is denied the opportunity to reach their full potential as a result of stunting and poor early childhood development in the first 1000 days of life.





CHW ROLE IN SUPPORTING BREASTFEEDING

- Education awareness and discussing with pregnant moms feeding choices
- Home visiting in the first week after the child is born to support and observe breast feeding
- Addressing cultural beliefs and debunking myths around breastfeeding
- Linking to care the struggling moms
- Breastfeeding gatherings

SUCCESS STORIES AND IMPACT

Flourish Antenatal Scorecard: 2023



Antenatal Baseline & Endline surveys measure Flourish's impact on pregnant women's coping skills, knowledge, attitude & practise (KAP) related to stunting-protective behaviours in the first 1000 days of life.

Improvements in Exclusive Breastfeeding at Clinics supported by GGC trained CHWs: 2022-2023			
District	2022	2023	Difference
Ehlanzeni (MP)	31%	38%	+7%
Cape Winelands (WC)	42%	46%	+4%
Mopani (LP)	23%	27%	+4%
City of Johannesburg (GP)	39%	44%	+5%

CHALLENGES FACED BY CHWS

- Limited resources
- Inadequate training
- Workload and coverage
- Cultural practises post-delivery (Within the first six weeks)

FUTURE DIRECTIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

- Strengthen CHW programs by equipping CHWs with training
- Resource CHWs
- CHWs have potential to increase breastfeeding rates and improve child health outcome.
- Children only gets into contact with the facility 20 time during 1st 1000 days CHWs will always be there as the first contact resource for mothers.
