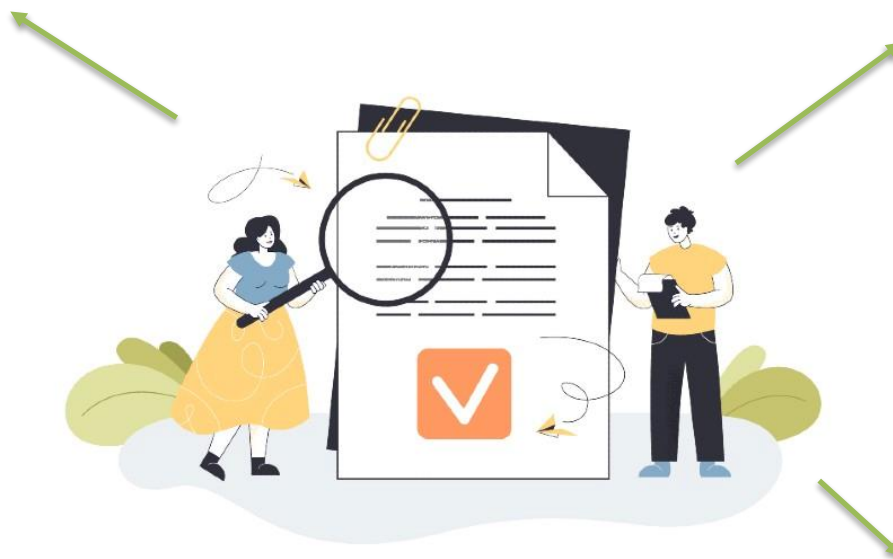


PHC/AHL STGs 2020-4 Review Cycle
