Raltegravir (RAL)

Formulations available:

- Chewable tablets: 25 mg, 100 mg (scored, dividable)
- Film-coated tablets: 400 mg (data on crushing this tablet is lacking: swallow whole or use chewable tablet formulations)
- Note: Film-coated tablets and chewable tablets are NOT interchangeable (different dosing applies)
- [Granules for oral suspension: single use packet of 100 mg RAL for suspension in 10 ml water (10 mg/ml) (Not yet registered in SA, available on compassionate use access from manufacturer with SAHPRA Sec 21 approval)]

Dosing:

- Neonatal dose (refer to Table below):
 - Birth age 7 days:
 - 1.5 mg/kg/dose once daily

Note: If the mother has taken RAL 2-24 hours before delivery, the neonate's first dose should be given between 24-48 hours after birth.

• Aged 8-28 days:

3 mg/kg/dose twice daily
