NOTICE: PUBLICATION OF THE NATIONAL ESSENTIAL MEDICINES LIST (NEMLC) APPROVED UPDATES TO THE PRIMARY HEALTHCARE (PHC) AND ADULT HOSPITAL LEVEL CHAPTERS: GASTRO-INTESTINAL CONDITIONS, ALIMENTARY TRACT AND EMERGENCIES AND INJURIES, FOR THE STANDARD TREATMENT GUIDELINES (STGs) AND ESSENTIAL MEDICINES LIST (EML) (2024 EDITION)

The 2024 editions of the PHC and Adult Hospital Level STGs and EML are currently under review. Updates to chapters and supporting technical documents (medicine reviews, costing reports and NEMLC reports) for the 2020-4 review cycle are uploaded onto the National Department of Health Knowledge Hub eLibrary and the NHI webpage as they are finalised for publication.
