The following chapters have been reviewed and *ratified for external comment*, with the respective NEMLC reports and relevant medicine review(s). The commenting period closed on **18 September 2024**.

The following items were reviewed by NEMLC:

➤ Long-acting Cabotegravir (CAB-LA) — The NDOH has received a donation of injectable CAB-LA from the US President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR). The NEMLC has noted the donation as accepted by the NDoH, in accordance with the SAHPRA's medicine donations policy. The CAB-LA evidence review document has been updated to include NEMLCs considerations for programmatic implementation and sustainability of supply. CAB-LA remains a non-EML medicine, until such time that more affordable generic alternatives become available. NEMLC will then reconsider the EML status of this medicine. ➤ Epilepsy STG — The PHC and Adult Hospital Level ERC developed an algorithm to promote understanding of the different epilepsy treatment choices included in the PHC and Adult Hospital Level STGs and EML, which was ratified by NEMLC for external comment.

The following items were reviewed by NEMLC:

➤ Morphine extemporaneous preparation — Paediatric related concerns were raised regarding the alcohol content in the morphine extemporaneous preparation using the commercially available Nipastat. Refer to Notice 2024/10/03/EDP/01 for guidance on the use of morphine extemporaneous preparation in children under the age of 6 years old where higher alcohol content is of concern.



TERTIARY AND QUATERNARY HOSPITAL LEVEL ESSENTIAL MEDICINES LIST

The following items were reviewed by NEMLC:

Phosphodiesterase-5 (PDE5) Inhibitors in Adults with WHO group 1 Pulmonary Arterial Hypertension (PAH) – The medicine review on PDE5 inhibitors in adults with World Health Organisation (WHO) group 1 PAH was presented to NEMLC. NEMLC recommended the inclusion of PDE5-inhibitors as a class (sildenafil, tadalafil and vardenafil) for this indication.



HAEMOPHILIA SUBCOMMITTEE

The following items were reviewed by NEMLC:

- ➤ Emicizumab Criteria for use NEMLC previously approved, in principle, the inclusion of emicizumab (June 2024) as a special access item for severe haemophilia A patients with inhibitors, pending the development of a criteria for use document. NEMLC ratified the criteria for use document and recommended that the use of emicizumab be carefully monitored by health establishments and Provincial Pharmaceutical and Therapeutics Committees (PTCs).
- ➤ Haemophilia STGs NEMLC ratified the Blood and Blood Forming Organs chapters for the Adult and Paediatric Level STGs and EML for finalisation and publication.






